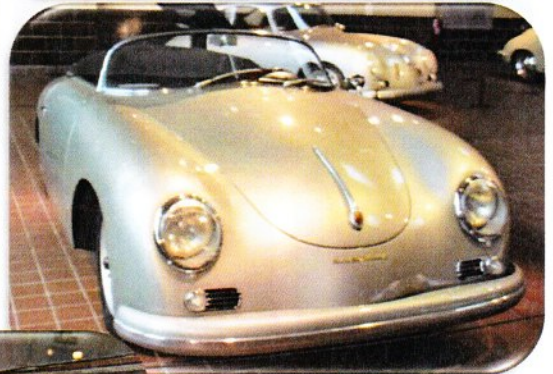
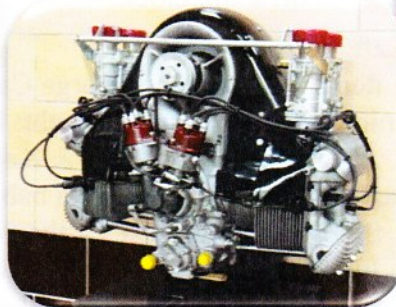
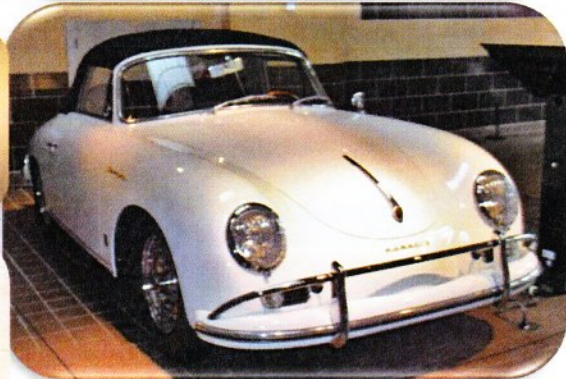
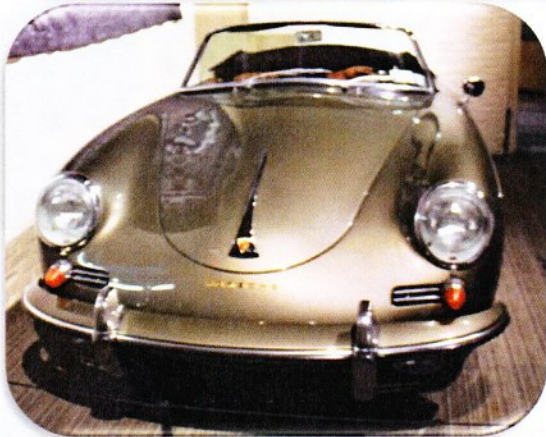
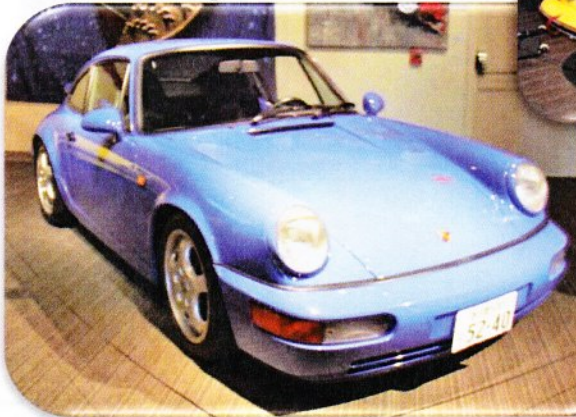


The building was a former bottling plant.

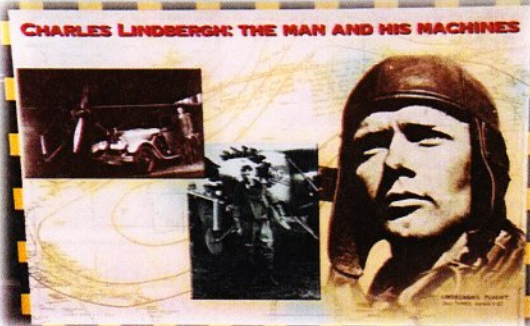
