CHEESE PUFFS


- | | |
|------------------------|---|
| 1 c. water | 4 large eggs, room temperature |
| 2 Tbsp butter | 1 ¼ c. shredded Gruyere or Swiss Cheese |
| ½ tsp salt | 1 Tbsp Dijon mustard |
| 1/8 tsp cayenne pepper | ¼ c. grated Parmesan Cheese |
| 1 c. flour | |



In a large saucepan, bring the water, butter, salt and cayenne to a boil. Add flour all at once and stir until a smooth ball forms. Remove from the heat; let stand for 5 minutes.

Add eggs, 1 at a time, beating well after each addition. Continue until mixture is smooth and shiny. Stir in Gruyere or Swiss cheese and mustard.


Drop by 1-inch balls 2 inches apart on greased baking sheets. Sprinkle with Parmesan cheese. Bake at 425 for 15-20 minutes or until golden brown. Serve warm or cold.

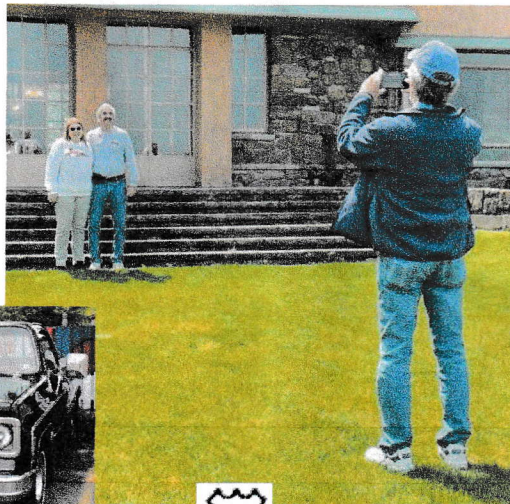

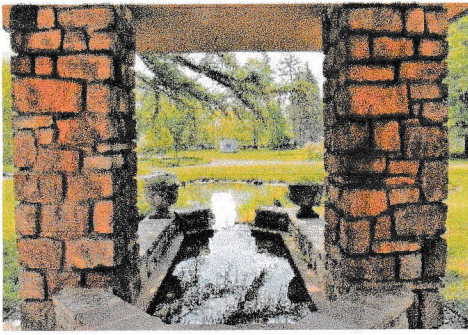

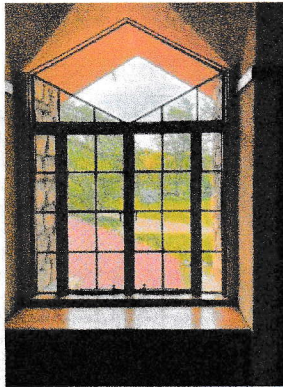

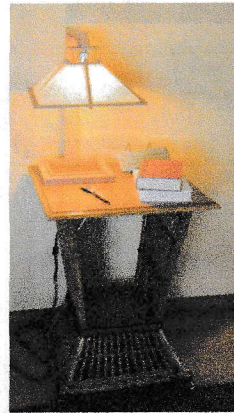

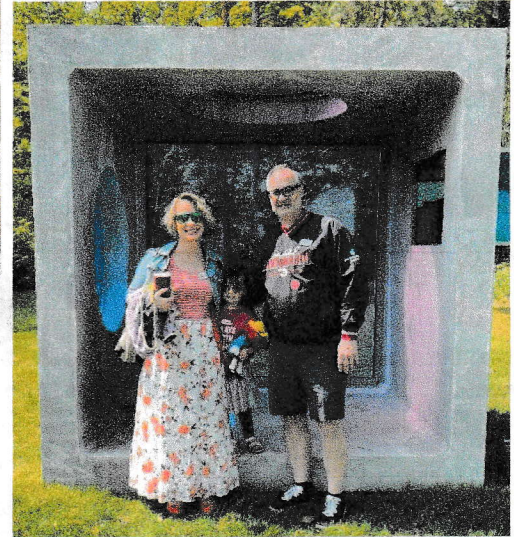

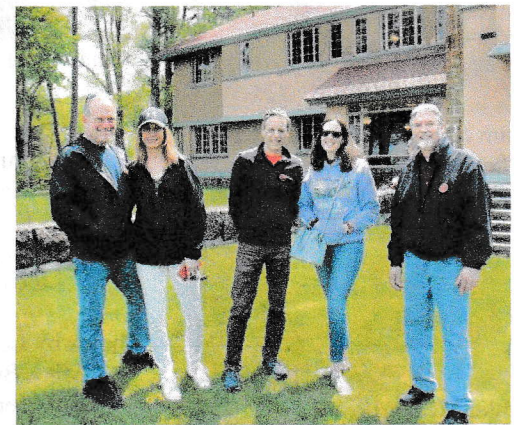

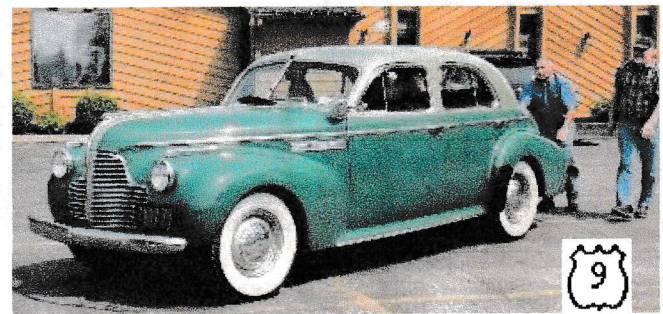
