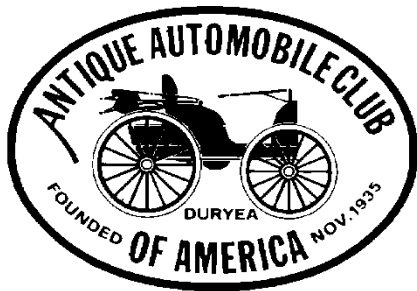

Each year hundreds of vehicles from the 1890s through 1932 arrive from across the country to be perfectly set in the place where American history is brought to life. Old car enthusiasts from all parts of the country celebrate early American motoring by displaying and driving their vintage car(s) in Greenfield Village at The Henry Ford 'Old Car Festival' 2-day event.

This year's 70th annual 'Old Car Festival' was held on the weekend of September 11th & 12th. As in past years, participants drove their antique vehicle into Greenfield Village and parked in designated areas on Friday evening before the event was open to the public the following Saturday morning. More than seven hundred antique vehicles had pre-registered for the 2021 Old Car Festival.

On Friday evening after check-in a special "participant mixer" took place at the Lodge located on the grounds of Greenfield Village. The popular mixer included a nice selection of drinks and light snacks. The only potential downside to attending was the limited seating had already been scooped up leaving both Candace and I with our hands occupied holding our refreshments with no place to sit.

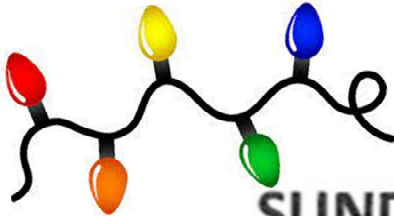
