

Macaroni and Cheese

1 cup elbow noodles (4 ozs)

1/4 cup chopped onion 1 Tbsp butter

Dash of pepper

1 1/4 cup milk

2 cups shredded American cheese

1 med. tomato, diced

Cook macaroni according to package directions.
 Drain well.

- 2. Meanwhile, for cheese sauce, in a saucepan cook onion in butter until tender but not brown. Stir in flour and pepper. Add milk all at once. Cook and stir till slightly thickened and bubbly. Add shredded cheese; stir until melted.
- 3. Stir macaroni into cheese sauce. Transfer to a 1- quart casserole dish. Bake uncovered in a 350 degrees oven for 25-30 minutes or till bubbly. During the last 5 minutes of baking, add the tomatoes. Let stand 10 minutes. Enjoy

Sunday, October 16,2022


We will meet at 9:30-10:00 AM in Danny's rear parking lot on the corner of route 20A and Abbott Rd. in Orchard Park, NY.


