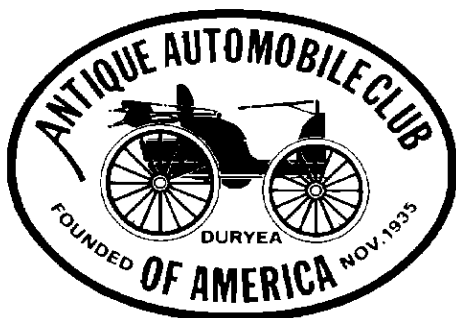

### Garden Vegetable Soup

2/3 c. sliced carrots	1/4 tsp oregano
3 c. chicken broth	1 1/2 c. diced green cabbage
1 Tbsp. tomato paste	1/2 tsp basil
1/4 tsp salt	1/2 c. diced zucchini
1/2 c. onion	2 garlic cloves, minced
1/2 c. green beans, fresh	



In a large saucepan, sprayed with non-stick cooking spray, sauté the carrots, onion, and garlic over low heat until softened (about 5 minutes) Add broth, cabbage, beans, tomato paste, basil, oregano, and salt. Bring to a boil. Lower heat and simmer covered about 15 minutes or until beans are tender. Stir in zucchini and heat 3-4 minutes.

### George Nash turns 104

*Continued from last month*

In April 1941, George bought a 1941 Chevy for \$840; his monthly payment was \$31. In spring of 1942, George and Mary rented a flat of a two-story home on Stillwell in Kenmore with a coal furnace and monthly rent of \$50. Two children arrived in 1946 and 1948, so in spring of 1951, the family bought a house on Coventry Road in Tonawanda. That house was built in 1948 and cost \$13,500. George had a 1951 green Chevy at the time. The Nashes moved to Burnside Drive in Tonawanda in January 1960, paid \$27,500 and the monthly payment was \$104, which was paid off in 1980.

George was involved in the 1953 power glide engine program at the Tonawanda plant that led to the 235 Corvette engines. In December 1952, a meeting was held in Detroit with the purpose of changing the 1953 235 power glide equipped engines to full pressure oil from the old rod dipper setup, replacing the poured babbitt rod bearing with precision inserts and changing the piston from iron to aluminum. At the GM building in Detroit, George and a fellow employee, Joe Petro, were given the task of determining if this could be done as the other GM plants had said they couldn't do it. George and Joe took the engine blueprints out of the office, laid them on the floor next to the

office and went over the plan part by part. George and Joe were able to work through processes that could make this happen and the end conclusion with hard work, significant overtime and a bit of luck, "the Tonawanda plant could do it". In 1953 all power glides had to be made at the Tonawanda plant.

Another highlight in George's career was his promotion to Department Head of Industrial Engineering in 1956. In 1958, George ran into the plant manager on the main aisle, and was told to "Go order a car!" So George had a variety of company cars starting in 1958 that he drove for 3K miles before turning them in for another one. His kids got to enjoy some really cool cars as they grew up too. (see note below\*)

George had a very successful career for 42 years, retiring in 1980. He smiles when he comments that he has now been retired longer than he worked.

\* Note: No one at the plant liked to drive 4-speed cars, so George brought them home for the kids to put miles on them. Some of these gems included: 1966 red 396 Chevelle 4-speed convertible, 1966 and 1967 maroon 427 Corvettes, Z28 302 Camaro, 1967 blue Chevelle 4-speed, 1968 327 Corvette 4-speed, 1966 black Caprice convertible.

SUNDAY, AUGUST 14, 2022

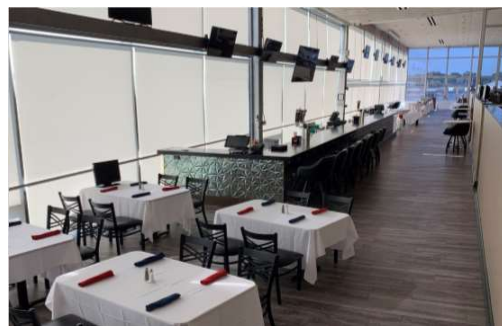

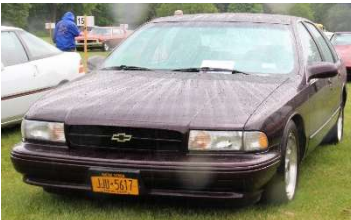

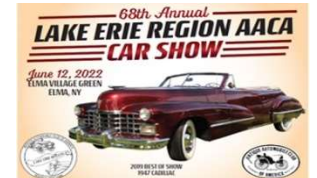
