






After dinner, Sue Cervie, director of Cornerstone Manor, (where our Christmas gifts will be donated), will give a brief talk on the history of Cornerstone.







Recipes

A couple of members were kind enough to share their recipes from Dessert Night. Enjoy!!

Blueberry Coffee Cake from Lee Hartung

1 tube Crescent Roll sheet Blueberry Pie filling Handful of raisins 1 egg ½ cup sugar 1 – 8oz Cream Cheese

Roll out dough. Combine Cream Cheese, sugar & egg. Spread on center of dough. Top with filling, fold long sides of dough together and pinch to seal. Bake till golden brown (350° for 20 minutes) Let cool, then spread with glaze.

Frosting 1 cup 10x sugar Water to make smooth (1/8 -1/4 cup)

Apple Crisp by George Camann

10 cups all-purpose apples, peeled, cored and sliced

1 cup white sugar

1 tablespoon all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

½ cup water

1 cup quick-cooling oats

1 cup all-purpose flour

1 cup packed brown sugar

1/4 teaspoon baking powder

1/4 teaspoon baking soda

½ cup butter, melted

Preheat oven to 350°. Place the sliced apples in a 9x13 inch pan. Mix the white sugar, 1 tablespoon flour and ground cinnamon together, and sprinkle over apples. Pour water evenly over all. Combine the oats, 1 cup flour, brown sugar, baking powder, baking soda and melted butter together. Crumble evenly over apple mixture. Bake at 350° for about 45 minutes.



Cherry Dump Cake from Lee Hartung

2 cans Cherry Pie Filling

1 white cake mix

1 stick butter – cut into slices

Spray bottom of 9 x 13 pan with Pam. Dump pie filling in pan. Sprinkle dry cake mix on filling. Dot cake mix with butter. Bake 350° about 35 minutes until bubbly.

White Texas Sheet Cake by Ruth Camann

In large sauce pan bring to a boil:

1 cup butter or margarine

1 cup water

Remove from heat: stir in:

2 cups flour

2 cups sugar

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. baking soda

2 eggs, beaten

½ cup sour cream

1 tsp. almond extract

Pour into greased 15 x 10" pan.

Bake at 350° for 20-22 minutes.

Prepare frosting just before done cooking to pour over warm cake.

Frosting

Bring to a boil, and remove from heat:

½ cup butter or margarine

½ cup milk

Add, mix till smooth, pour over warm cake:

4 ½ cups confectioner's sugar (sift in)

Sprinkle over:

1 cup chopped walnuts (optional)

Spread over warm cake.


